## AFFILIATION, CURRICULUM AND ACADEMIC TERMS

The institution is affiliated with Federal Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education (FBISE) Islamabad, which upholds stringent standards in education. The students are prepared for the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC) examinations conducted by the Federal Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Islamabad (FBISE). ## SPORTS AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Sports are vital for physical and mental fitness. We provide a conducive atmosphere for indoor and outdoor games. Almost all major games i.e Football, Basketball, Hockey, Volleyball, Cricket, Badminton, Squash and Table Tennis are played here. Gymnastics, Athletics and Martial Arts are an addition to the games' programme. The College holds Inter-house competitions (Seniors / Juniors both) and also takes part in Inter Schools / Colleges Sports Galas / Competitions organized by the Federal Board and Sports Clubs / Organizations. The College team (Sports) has won major outdoor and indoor games organized by the Federal Board for the last many years. The College Squash and Basketball teams have also represented the Federal Board in the Inter Boards Sports Competitions and won laurels for the Federal Board as well as for the College.



For a balanced personality, co-curricular activities are equally important. Our students participate in Inter-house competitions and also show their abilities at Pakistan level. To inculcate innovative ideas and creative skills in the students, a number of Hobbies Club activities exist at the College. The list of Hobbies Club activities include Aeromodelling, Science, History, Calligraphy, Geography, Music, Arts, Wood Works, Crafts, English/Urdu Literary, Photography, Dramatics, Computer, Martial Arts and Gymnastics. These are part of our co-curricular activities. Each student participates in a Hobby Club activity of his choice in the afternoons twice in a week. Inter-House Quiz / Declamation Contests are also held in the College to ensure balanced mental growth of the young Topians. House-wise educational Visits / Excursions / Camping and Picnics are also part of our Programme which help the students in their healthy social grooming.





## HOUSES AND PRE CADETS' MESS

PAF College, Lower Topa is a residential institution. We have no day-only scholars. The students are accommodated in six houses, namely Aurangzeb, Babur, Iqbal, Siraj-ud-Daula, Sir Syed and Tipu Sultan. Each house is under the charge of a Housemaster who is assisted by an Assistant Housemaster and a Physical Training Instructor (PTI). Each house also has a House Captain from amongst the students who is Incharge of various House activities.



The Mess functions under the supervision of a dedicated Mess Manager and the Food Committee. Meals include breakfast, mid- morning snacks, lunch, evening tea, dinner and milk.





## MEDICAL, UNIFORM & ALLIED FACILITIES

The College has a Medical Squadron with doctors and medical staff for providing a round-the-clock medical care. There is a Medical Ward for detention of Pre-cadets. The Medical Squadron also has basic medical services for medical investigation of the students. On admission to CMH in Murree, our students stay in the Officers' Ward. In case a student needs a surgical procedure, all efforts are made to inform his parents / guardians before the operation. However, if there is no time to inform them then the student would be operated upon without any delay. The parents / guardians of the students are required to submit a written permission for emergency surgery.



The Pre-cadets have to be in the prescribed dress, different for different activities. The uniform and selected items are provided to the students by the College, free of cost. Any willful damage to the uniform items is charged to the parents. Use of private dress is permitted on Weekends and while proceeding on book-outs, educational visits, excursions and leave. On initial joining, students are required to be in possession of clothing items as given in the joining instructions. These are needed by the students prior to the issuance of uniform kit items.



Support facilities such as Cafeteria , Barber Shop, Laundry, Cobbler's Shop, Tailor's Shop, Post Box, Bank etc are available within the premises and proximity of the College.





## RULES OF CONDUCT

### Students are NOT permitted to keep the following:

- . Transistors, video games, mobile phones (smart phones) other gadgets or electrical appliances.
- . Unauthorised medicines.
- . Money (other than authorized pocket money).
- . Valuables like digital camera etc.
- . Use of Social Media is prohibited.

### Actions by the students which may result in termination from the College:

- . Cheating, lying, stealing and immoral conduct.
- . Willfully and deliberately damaging the College property.
- . Keeping fire-arms, knives or any weapon.
- . Breaking College bounds.
- . Misconduct with faculty or staff.
- . Absence from class or any College activity without proper permission or cause.
- . Smoking.
- . In-appropriate behaviour of students' Parents / guardians towards faculty or staff.
- . Being habitually ill-disciplined and untidy.
- . Continuously poor performance in academics.
- . Non-payment of College dues.
- . Breach of any other College rule.

### Note

The decisions taken by the "Discipline Council" and "Academic Council" in all discipline and academic matters are final subject to approval by Air Headquarters and cannot be challenged.



## DAILY SCHEDULE, TRAINING & CORRESPONDENCE

The daily schedule is drawn up with a view to making optimum utilization of time. It begins with physical exercises in the College Sports Ground, breakfast in the Pre-cadets' Mess followed by morning assembly. There are seven classes a day, except on Friday. In order to enhance the sports hours for the Pre-cadets, alternate Saturday is also observed as Sports Day. In the afternoon, the Pre-cadets go to the hobbies club of their choice and aptitude, followed by the games supervised by the College faculty, PTIs and coaches. In the evening, the boys attend two-hours supervised study in their respective classrooms / Prep Rooms. Thus the daily programme aims to ensure that adequate time is provided for the development of all facets of a student's personality and abilities. As such, equal stress is laid on academic as well as moral, intellectual and physical activities.



### Bond Liability

Selected students are required to join Pakistan Air Force after completing their training at PAF College Lower Topa. **The Parents / Guardians of students would be required to furnish a bond to the effect that their son / ward would serve the Flying or any other Branch of Pakistan Air Force.**

### Joint Military Education & Training Programme (JMET)

After Matriculation, few Pre-cadets may be sent to Army / Navy Cadet Colleges for two years training under the Joint Military Education and Training Programme and will return to PAF College Lower Topa at the end of this period.

### Visits by Parents / Guardians

The Parents / Guardians may visit their sons / wards on any Sunday during the term. No visits during weekdays are allowed. Parents / Guardians are allowed to meet their sons / wards in the Visitors' Centre only. Snacks and beverages are available on payment at the College Tuck Shop located at the Visitors' Centre or parents / guardians may bring edibles from home except any cooked food. Parents may meet Housemasters / Assistant Housemasters or subject teachers during the visit.

**Visitors are not permitted to enter the Houses / Dormitories and Pre-cadets' Mess. The Visitors' Centre is specifically designated to facilitate parents / families to see their wards.**



## DAILY SCHEDULE, TRAINING & CORRESPONDENCE

### Leave

Generally, 08 weeks Winter Break and 02 weeks Summer Break are given to the students. Leave other than these holidays is authorized by the College, only in cases of extreme emergency or compassionate grounds.

### College Dues

Students who gain admission to this College pay the following dues:

### Pocket Money

The College provides pocket money to the Pre-cadets Rs.1000.00 each per month for Classes 8th, 9th & 10th and Rs.1200.00 each per month for 1st year & 2nd year. No additional money is to be given or sent by Parents / Guardians except travel expenses, which are to be deposited with the Housemasters.

## DAILY SCHEDULE, TRAINING & CORRESPONDENCE

### Library

The College has a well-equipped library manned by a trained librarian and other staff. In addition, a small library has been established in each "House" to help the students develop the habit of reading. Modern educational aids like Multimedia Projector, e-lalibrary are available.



### Language Lab

To provide the students ample exposure to spoken English, the College has established two well equipped Language Labs. The boys are exposed to a variety of well- chosen language programmes and given enough opportunity to polish their spoken expression under the guidance of trained teachers.



### Computer Lab

In order to keep pace with the technological advancement, especially with the boom in information technology, the College has two modern Computer Labs equipped with latest computers.



### Scholarships

Topians' Foundation offers two full five years scholarships to the selected students on need basis.

## ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission to the College is made in class VIII every year subject to conditions given below:

### Eligibility Criteria

- (a) **Age**  
Not under 11 years 6 months and not over 13 years 6 months of age on 1st January, 2024.
- (b) **Qualification**  
The candidate must have passed class VII at the time of admission (April, 2024). Candidates studying in Cambridge system can also apply.
- (c) **Citizenship**  
Should be a male citizen of Pakistan or Azad Jammu & Kashmir.

### Selection Procedure

The Selection process consists of the following three phases.

- Phase-I** Intelligence Test, Academic Test, Preliminary Medical & Initial Interview
- Phase-II** Board Interview
- Phase-III** Final Medical Examination

## ADMISSION PROCESS

### Phase-I Intelligence Test, Academic Test, Preliminary Medical & Initial Interview

The eligible Candidates are required to appear for the following tests at PAF Information & Selection Centers (PAF I & SCs).

#### Intelligence Test

At first, candidates are required to appear in the Intelligence Test. This will be E-Test (Electronic Test) to be attempted by the candidates on computers. This determines the IQ of a candidate.

#### Academic Test

Candidates qualifying the Intelligence Test are required to appear for Academic Test (E-Test). Academic Test comprises four subjects i.e. Maths, General Science, English & Urdu

#### Syllabi for Academic Test

The syllabi for the Academic Test is given at the subsequent pages in the Prospectus. The test is a competitive examination, therefore, the syllabi given in the Prospectus is meant only for the general guidance of the candidate. By and large, the questions in the test papers are based on the syllabi in vogue in various Textbook Boards in Pakistan.

**Note:** Sample Question Papers of Intelligence Test and Academic Test are attached at the end of Prospectus.

#### Preliminary Medical

Candidates qualifying the Academic test will undergo preliminary medical test. This test takes place at PAF Information & Selection Centres, observing the basic medical standards for Flying Branch of Pakistan Air Force. The candidate should be free from deformities of hands, feet, spine and chest. The visual and hearing systems should be in perfect condition. Moreover, the candidate should not be affected by skin and dental diseases. The Torso Height should fall between the laid down upper and lower limits for the Flying Branch. There should be no squint, defective vision and colour blindness.

#### Note:

The candidate must have 6/6 eye sight / vision without glasses. **Candidates, who wear glasses, should not apply.** Opinion of PAF Medical Officer conducting the test is final. No appeal in this regard is admissible.

## ADMISSION PROCESS

### Initial Interview

Candidates qualifying the preliminary medical test will be required to appear in Initial Interview to evaluate the candidate personality in general.

### Phase-II Board Interview

The successful candidates in Phase-I are to appear for the Board Interview. The candidate is asked questions about the basic general / subject knowledge. The Board evaluates the candidate's personality, character traits, comprehension, expression, emotional stability and confidence.

### Phase-III Final Medical Examination

Candidates selected in Board Interview are called for the Final Medical Test at Islamabad, Lahore / Sargodha and Karachi. Medical Board examines selected candidates thoroughly according to the requirements of Flying Branch. The decision of **Medical Board** is **Final** and no appeal against the decision is entertained.

### Final Selection

Candidates who qualify the Final Medical Examination are included in the merit list for the final selection. The call up letter along with joining instructions are sent to the successful candidates only.

**FINAL SELECTION IS MADE STRICTLY BY FOLLOWING  
ORDER OF MERIT, MERIT ONLY.**

## RETENTION AT PAF COLLEGE LOWER TOPA

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR RETENTION AT PAF COLLEGE LOWER TOPA

#### Medical Examination

- (a) Students are required to undergo an annual medical examination by the College Medical Officer during the five years stay at PAF College, Lower Topa. Medically unfit students are discharged / withdrawn.
- (b) Medical Examination by CMB is held after ISSB.

#### Matric

After completion of Matric, only those boys who obtain First Division (Grade A+, A & B) are allowed to continue further studies up to FSc.

After FSc (First Division holders) only those students who qualify ISSB and are declared medically fit by CMB, are eligible to join PAF Academy Asghar Khan, Risalpur. Since PAF invest substantial resources and money on the training and grooming of Pre-cadets for five years, therefore, first chance of ISSB is mandatory for Pre-cadets to be taken exclusively for GD (P), however the 2nd chance is open to be attempted for sister services (Army, Navy). The ISSB results of last 19 years reveal that majority of the Pre-cadets joined PAF Academy Asghar Khan, Risalpur.



## PAF College Lower Topa

is a residential institution run on classical public school lines. The aim is to impart quality education as well as to provide a healthy environment that would help produce confident, disciplined and courageous young men possessing a strong character and qualities of Command and Leadership.
